Grooming Report

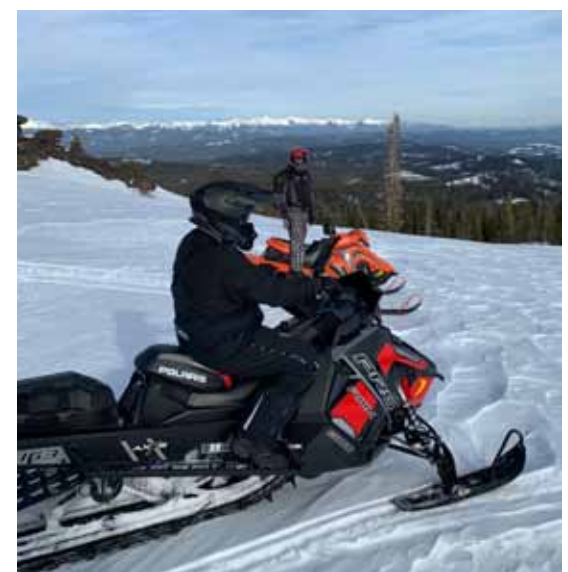
Trails are looking good. Just need the fluffy white stuff on them. Groomer is ready to go out to play.

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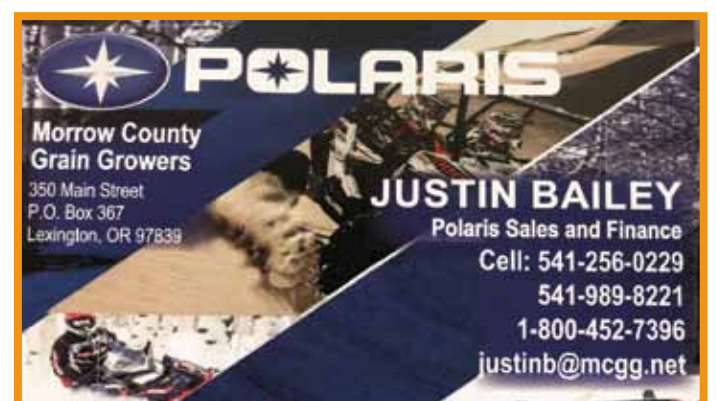

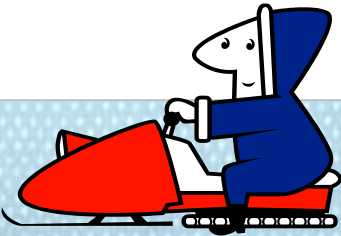

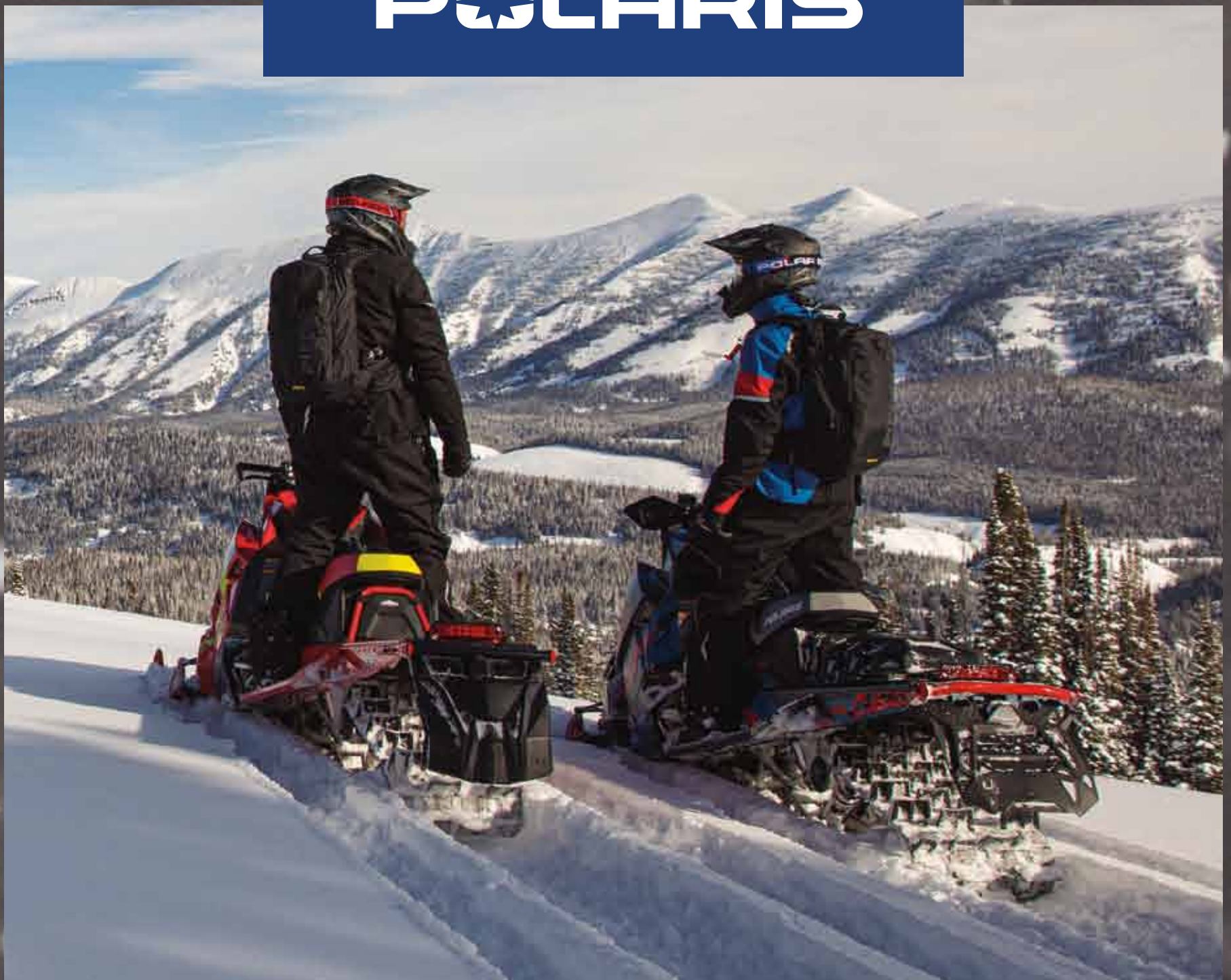
